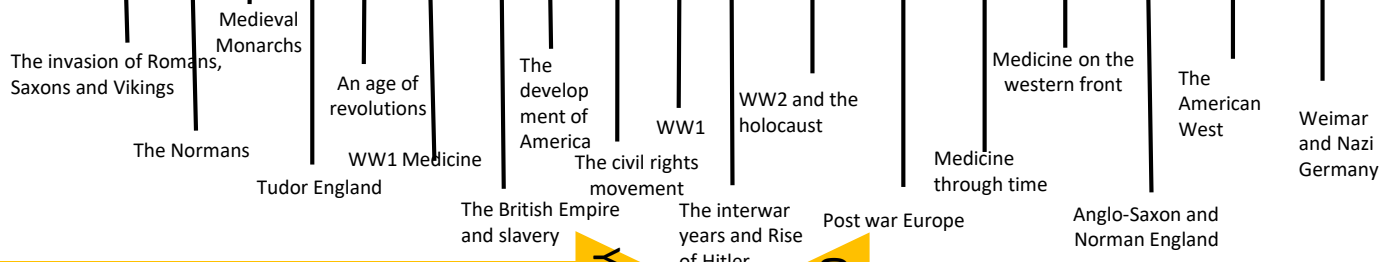


History Knowledge Map

Year 7

Year 9

After the failed Munich Putsch and lean years support for the Nazis started to grow from 1929 onwards.

Year 10
How have political ideologies affected the lives of people in Britain and around the world?
The political deal of 1932 and Reichstag fire helped Hitler establish control of Germany.

Year 10
How has medicine changed between 1250 and the modern day?
The Nazis established a police state and used propaganda to control Germany.

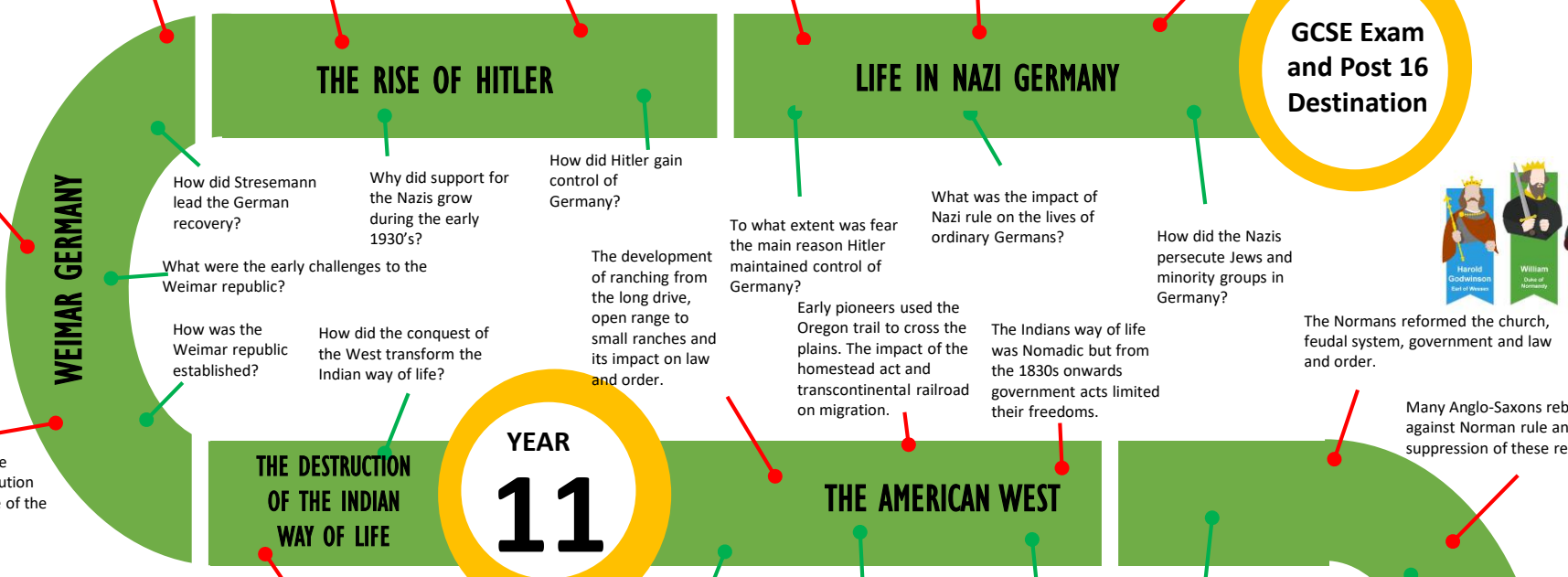
Year 11
