Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to confirm the details for the upcoming school 'Virtual Curriculum' day on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June. As you may be aware, for all Year 11 students completing their GCSE qualifications this year a 'Teacher Assessed Grade' (TAG) will be awarded.

To support the final aspects of the TAG allocation, all staff will be completing a series of moderation tasks on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June. Therefore, **all students from Years 7-10 will complete all lessons remotely, through TEAMS on this day.** Students will access the remote curriculum using their Year Group Virtual Curriculum through TEAMS.

Please see the link below **which outlines all aspects of the remote learning day** (including how to login and where to find all the learning resources for the 7<sup>th</sup> June 'Remote Learning day'). **All lessons will focus on the upcoming 'End of Year Assessments'.**

Students will have this information shared with them through form time during this week. They will also have the opportunity to reset their TEAMS password. Should they need to.

#### Outline / Key information for the day – all details are included in the above MP4 link

- All learning will be completed remotely, through TEAMS
- Students will access all learning tasks using the Virtual Curriculum for their specific year group
- Students will need to register remotely between 8:45-9.00am. Students need to login to TEAMS, open their form TEAM and enter their name. **They do not need to register for any other lessons**
- All lessons are planned as 50 minute lessons; this is to allow a break from screens for students
- Students follow their normal school timetable, completing the lessons they would normally complete on a Monday (week 1)
- To support all learners, work will be available for the whole of the week commencing 7<sup>th</sup> June, should students need to revisit the learning tasks, after the Monday
