Dear Parent/Carer

I hope that you and your families are well.

We are writing to provide you with more information in regards to the virtual curriculum that Year 11 students will be required to follow after half term. As you will be aware from previous communication, the official leaving date is Friday 25th June. However, from the 7th June, students will not be attending school in person. During this time, they will be working at home following our virtual curriculum on TEAMS in much the same way as they have done on previous occasions in lockdown.

- Students should register each morning between 8:45-9am. They will do so by attending their form group TEAM, and writing their name in the form 'chat'. This is the same process that was followed during lockdown 2. Parents of students who do not register can expect a phone call/email from Miss Hall to account for any absences.
- The chat function in TEAMS will be removed. All online behaviours through TEAMS will be monitored. Any behaviours which are not in line with the school Remote Learning policy will result in your child being removed from the learning tasks provided.
- All work can be accessed through the Virtual Curriculum – Year 11 TEAM, in the 'files' sub folder (link below). Work will be centred on careers exploration, life skills, citizenship, and transition to post 16 provision. There will be no need for students to submit any work. If there are any technical questions regarding the access of work via TEAMS, please contact Mr Hayfield. All other curriculum enquiries should be sent to Mrs Mohamed.
