

### **TAG Appeal – Stage 1 (Centre appeal) – appeals between 12/8/21 and 3/9/21**

**Procedural** – the candidate believes that the Centre Policy (shared and available on the school website – TAG webpage) was not followed correctly.

**Administrative** – the candidate believes that the transfer of marks from assessment(s) to the TAG data entry has not completed correctly

Please note that any applications for ‘Special Considerations’ were requested from parents on **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> May**, and were also completed by leaders at the school to identify if these were valid. All special consideration has been applied to students where valid.

All students that would ordinarily have received ‘access arrangements’ (support in completing assessments) were provided for all TAG assessments.

A Stage 1 appeal can be made if you believe either or both of the above may have occurred. Stage 1 appeals are completed through the document linked below. Stage 1 appeals must be made before any Stage 2 appeals can be applied for.

### **TAG Appeal – Stage 2 (Examination body appeal) – appeals between 10/9/21 and 17/9/21**

If after a Stage 1 (centre) appeal has been completed you will receive either;

**Appeal upheld** – upon completion of the review, an error was identified. The TAG will be changed. This will be shared by the school, to the candidate.

**Appeal rejected** – upon completion of the review, no error was identified. The TAG remains the same. This will be shared by the school, to the candidate.

Upon completion of an unsuccessful Stage 1 appeal the candidate may apply for a Stage 2 Examination Board review. This would occur if;

- The updated TAG from the previous appeal the candidate still believes to be incorrect
- The candidate believes that the centre (school) has failed to apply ‘reasonable academic judgement’ when generating the candidates TAG

The candidate applies for this appeal through the school, but the appeal will be completed by the examination board. This appeal can only be applied for once as Stage 1 appeal has been completed.
