- Group 1 (Surname A-G) – 8:30 – 9:15am
- Group 2 (Surname H-Q) – 9:15-10am
- Group 3 (Surname P-Z) – 10- 10:45am

It is essential that students follow any Covid-19 protocols in place, which may include wearing facemasks depending on the latest government advice at the time.

If your child is unable to attend in person, they can nominate a close relative to collect results on their behalf.
