Drinking Water



With the weather getting warmer, please can you ensure that your child has plenty of water with them to last the day.

Bike Safety



If your child cycles to school, please can you remind them to wear helmets, and where possible high visibility accessories. Please also remind them to observe the laws of the road whilst travelling around on their bikes, for their own safety, and that of others on the road.

Parking Around School

Whilst waiting outside school to collect your children, could we please ask that you turn your engines off. At Light Hall School we would like to assist in ensuring the health of students, community and the environment around us.

An idling engine can produce up to twice the emissions of a car that's in motion. These include chemicals such as Sulphur dioxide, particulate matter and nitrogen oxide to name a few.

All of these contribute to asthma, heart disease and even lung cancer. These chemicals also have a negative effect on the environment by contributing to poor air quality.

Stationary idling is also an offence under section 42 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.

Please remember to park considerately and legally outside school.
