Assessment Schedule – Key dates

o Dates

- **Mock 1** – all subjects W/c **28/11 – 16/12**
- **Mock 2** – most subjects W/c **20/3 – 31/3**
- **GCSE assessments** – all subjects May 2023
- **Reporting to parents** – **18/11** (full) WAG, **13/1** (mock 1) WAG and Predication, **21/4** (mock 2) WAG.

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Assessment preparation

o How can you support your child's preparation?

- Subjects will share topic lists at least x4 weeks before assessments (not the GCSE examinations)
- Range of platforms to support revision – SENECA, TEAMS, BBCBitesize, and many more
- Revision plans – timetable time to revise
- Make children aware of the importance of the assessment outcomes.

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Assessment outcomes

o Key reminders

- As a school we report 'working at grades' (WAGs) these are **NOT** predictions.
- Subjects will provide 'topic lists' / revision planners. These outline the content that could be assessed. **Not exhaustive.**
- Exam dates and seat numbers – **sent to student emails.** Essential students know these details. They are different for each examination.
- Make children aware of the importance of the assessment outcomes – Post-16 options use WAG.

Careers program in year 11

- All students to receive a 1-1 interview with a qualified impartial careers advisor. Students receive an advice sheet which they can bring home to share with you.
- Access to Kudos a careers platform with guidance and up to date information about apprenticeships and college courses.
- Careers day including Ask apprenticeships session.
- Careers fair hosted jointly with Langley school.
- Form tutor support including tracking and monitoring of post 16 applications.
- Intervention for students at risk of becoming NEET.
