

Year 10 and 11 students have been studying a variety of routes they could go down after Light Hall, and in particular have been looking at T Levels.


Year 8 have been answering questions to give them one of the below 'hats'. How could this help to think about future careers?

T Levels are new 2 year courses which follow GCSEs and are equivalent to 3 A levels.

T Levels offer students a mixture of classroom learning and 'onthe-job' experience during an industry placement of at least 45 days.
