<b>Festivals –</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Christmas – story behind the festival, the Christian celebrations, and their symbolism.</li> <li>• Easter –Holy week events and the celebrations and their symbolism</li> <li>• the celebrations of Christmas and Easter, including their importance for Christians in Great Britain today.</li> <li>•</li> </ul>			
<b>Role of the Church in the community</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• what is meant by the “church”,</li> <li>• Different ways churches support their communities- food banks and street pastors</li> </ul>
