<p>The origins and value of human life: Abortion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Religious teachings about the origins of human life abortion, and different interpretations of these</li> <li>The concepts of sanctity of life and the quality of life</li> <li>Abortion, including situations when the mother's life is at risk.</li> <li>Ethical arguments related to abortion, including those based on the sanctity of life and quality of life.</li> <li>Abortion and the law</li> </ul>			
<p>The origins and value of human life: Euthanasia.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Different types of euthanasia</li> <li>Euthanasia and the law</li> <li>Ethical arguments related to euthanasia including those based on the sanctity of life and quality of life.</li> <li>Religious teachings about Euthanasia</li> </ul>			
<p>Death and afterlife</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beliefs about death and an afterlife, and their impact on beliefs about the value of human life.</li> <li>Christian and Muslim beliefs about the afterlife.</li> </ul>
